The Humboldt Broncos, who are one of the premier Junior A organizations in Western Canada, would like to extend an invitation for you to attend our 2026 Spring Camp held on May 1st to 3rd at the Elgar Petersen Arena in Humboldt. The Humboldt Broncos hockey operations staff will be using this small, invite only camp for players born from 2007 to 2010. The purpose of this camp is to evaluate players who will potentially play for the 2026-2027 Humboldt Broncos as well as evaluate draft eligible players for the upcoming draft in June.

At the camp, all players will have a minimum of four one hour ice sessions followed by a 5th ice session for those selected to play in the Top 40 Game on Sunday, May 3rd. We will also host an information session for all players and parents to attend. All information pertaining to your times and schedule will be emailed out by Friday, April 24th. Registration will take place anytime before your first session on Friday.

The City of Humboldt is a great place to enjoy Junior Hockey. The Broncos practice and play out of the Elgar Petersen Arena, which is one of the top facilities for Junior A Hockey in Western Canada. We have a fitness centre just steps away from our newly renovated dressing room. We are lucky to have tremendous billets within our community as well as one of the most supportive fan bases in the SJHL.

Our organization stresses the importance of education. Humboldt Collegiate Institute is connected to the arena and offers a tremendous high school program. Many of our players take first and second year university classes at St. Peters College (affiliated with the University of Saskatchewan) located just 10 km east in Muenster.

The Humboldt Broncos have a strong reputation for helping players advance their hockey careers. Since 2019, We have had 4 players ranked on the NHL Central Scouting List. Since the Broncos were formed in 1970, 15 Bronco alumni have gone on to play and/or coach in the NHL. In the past 6 years, the Humboldt Broncos have advanced 12 players to NCAA Division 1, 16 players to USPORTS, and many more to various college and professional hockey leagues.

There are no hidden fees when you play for the Broncos. The team covers billets, and all external equipment. We are **NOT** a pay to play organization.

If you are interested in attending our spring camp and becoming a Bronco, register by completing the google form attached in the email by April 17th, 2026. An email will be sent to you within 48 hours to confirm your attendance. The cost of the camp is \$225 and the preferred form of payment is e-transfer and can be sent to hbroncos@sasktel.net. Training Camp Information

- Registration/Confirmation of attendance opens two hours prior to your first ice session on Friday, May 1st in the lobby of the Elgar Petersen Arena.
- All information pertaining to dressing rooms and rosters will be posted in the lobby. The schedule and roster for the camp will be emailed out by Friday, April 24th, 2026.
- There will be a jersey hanging in your dressing room for your first session that will be your responsibility for the weekend.
- While we will have a tentative schedule drawn in advance, the final schedule and rosters need to be confirmed. Our experience has shown that significant last-minute changes to the rosters have been required due to last-minute cancellations.
- Each player will be involved in a minimum of four sessions.
- Skate sharpening by our trainer will be available throughout the weekend. Our trainer will also do your laundry after the last session of the day if you wish.
